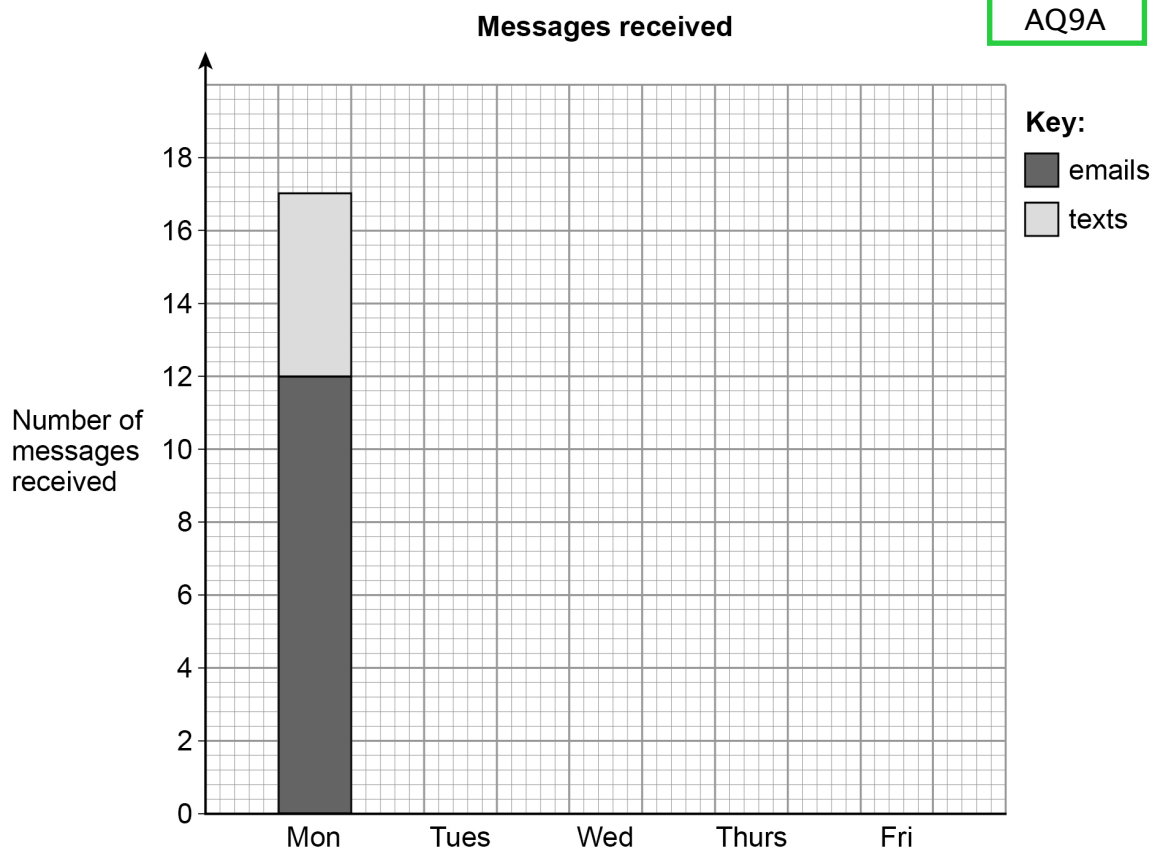


- 9 The table shows the number of messages Sam received each day for five days.
